Dog called Juice. - Senior dog

Condition: Chronic eye discharge

3. PURPOSE OF VISIT

Follow-up on veterinary treatment

4. FINDINGS & OBSERVATIONS

On 16 July 2026 at approximately 10:00 I attended Animal Welfare Society Philippi to check if the dog was brought back for follow-up treatment.

Met with Jacque and Michelle who confirmed that yes, the owner brought the dog on Saturday, 12 July 2026, for treatment.

They explained that the dog is an old dog.

The discharge from the eyes will not go away permanently.

They stated it appears the eyelashes are dropping onto the dog's eyes which is causing the discharge.

Due to the age of the dog, the condition may not improve and the dog may have to live with the discharge.

Owner was advised to clean the eyes in the mornings.

5. DISCUSSION & ACTION TAKEN

Confirmed with AWS Philippi staff that follow-up treatment was done on 12 July 2026.

: chronic discharge likely to persist.

Owner advised on daily cleaning regime.

6. OUTCOME & FOLLOW-UP

Case Status: MONITORING

Recommendation:

- Dog received follow-up treatment at AWS Philippi on 12 July 2026.
- Chronic eye discharge due to age/eyelashes. Condition not curable, only manageable.
- Owner to clean eyes daily.
- No further SPCA action required at this stage. Continue to monitor.
