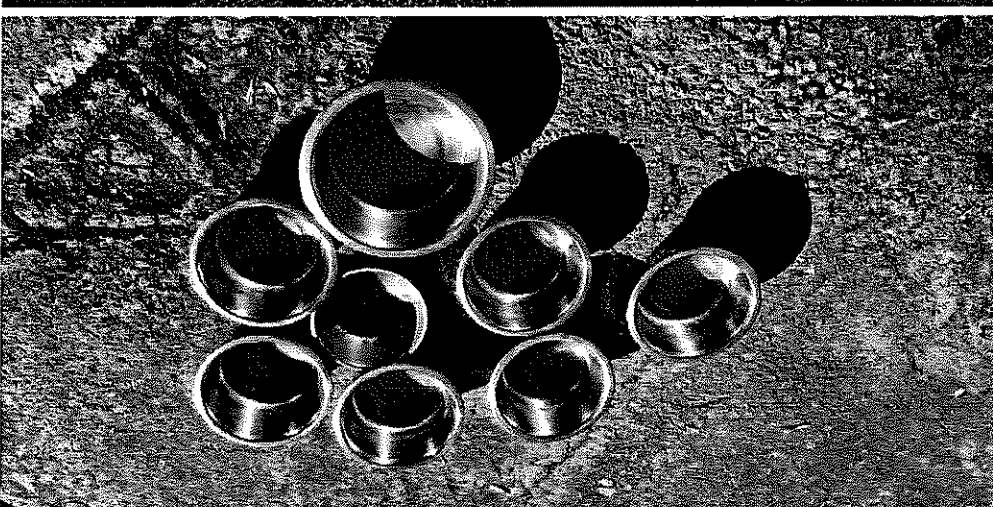
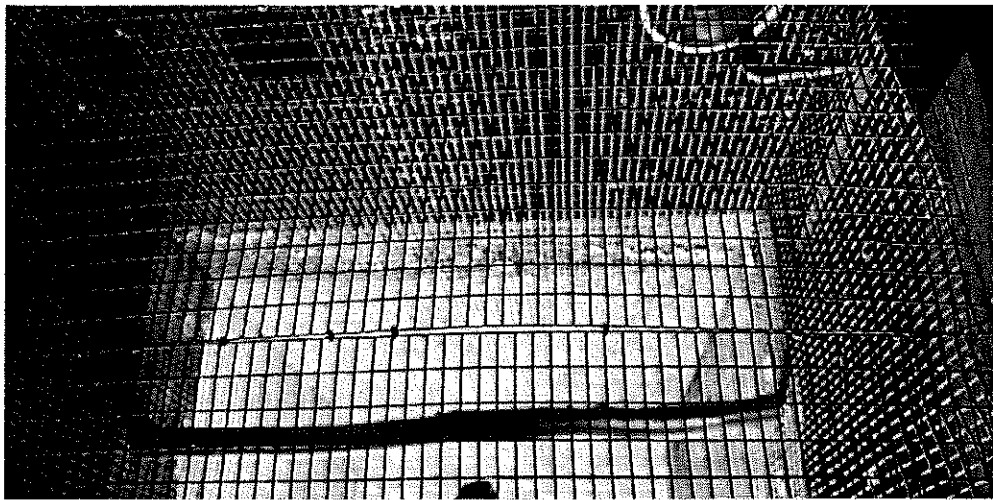
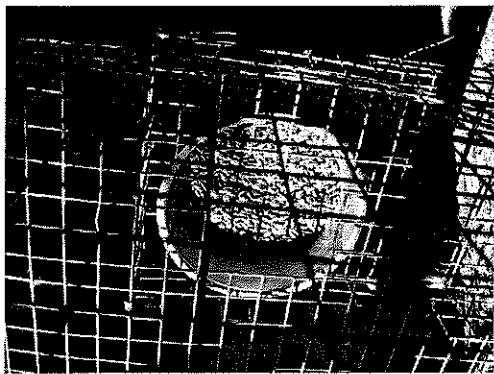
Clean after the birds on daily basis and disinfect the cages
