Subject: Complaint Regarding Dogs Escaping Property and Animal Welfare Concerns – 221 Kwartel Road, Birch Acres

Good afternoon,

I wish to formally lodge a complaint regarding ongoing issues involving dogs from the property situated at 221 Kwartel Road, Birch Acres, which have repeatedly escaped from the property and created both a public safety concern and an animal welfare concern. This is unfortunately not an isolated incident.

Yesterday afternoon, several dogs from this property (about 3 or 4 black and white pups, a larger dog, could be the father of the pups, as well as the emaciated brown dog) again escaped onto the road and ran directly toward my property, becoming aggressive and hysterical (which is natural) at my gate where my own dogs were inside. I was forced to try prevent a fight through my gate by attempting to chase the dogs away (by throwing buckets of water at them through my gate) while also trying to calm my own dogs.

During this incident, a woman from 221 Kwartel Road eventually came outside and attempted to retrieve the dogs. While this was happening, some of the dogs also approached and circled a pedestrian walking past, who had to defend herself using an umbrella.

This is particularly concerning because Kwartel Road is a busy road, and the dogs are at risk of being injured by vehicles, while members of the public and neighbouring animals are also being placed at risk.

There have been previous incidents as well (when I've called out hysterically to them, as I cannot exit my own garden to speak to them) :

- On one occasion, quite some time ago), a garden person at their property allegedly left the gate open while working, the garden person got the dogs in).
- On another occasion, I was advised that the gate was unable to close properly.
- The dogs have again managed to leave the property and roam freely in the street of late This seems to be a result of the gate not being closed properly? (it is a good secure gate from the outside).

As I understand it, municipal bylaws generally require that dogs be properly contained on private property and prohibit owners from allowing animals to roam freely on public roads or create a nuisance/public safety risk.

In addition to the above, I am also concerned about the condition of their one brown dog at the property, which appears severely underweight/emaciated, with visible ribs. This raises concerns regarding possible neglect and I believe it may warrant inspection.

I witnessed (as I was at my gate throwing buckets of water at their dogs to try to get them away, so that I could also get my own dogs away from my gate and inside my house, a resident at 219 Kwartel Road (he very likely heard me screaming) assisted in helping return the dogs to the property during yesterday's incident, for which I was grateful (he is a very kind gentleman).

I am concerned that if this matter is not addressed, someone may be injured, the dogs may be harmed by traffic, or another altercation may occur involving neighbouring pets.

I would appreciate it if my identity could remain confidential where possible, as I do not want conflict with neighbours or any retaliation involving my own dogs. (I'm sure they will assume it's me).

I care deeply about animal welfare and am raising this complaint because I believe this situation is unsafe for both the animals and the public.

Please can this matter be investigated and kept on record. I don't want any dog to get run over, bite a passerby, dogs to be injured through the gate and worst of all the jumping up at the gate to cause the gate to fall down, especially if I am not at home,
